

Wyoming Care Management Entity High Fidelity Wraparound: WFI-EZ



Wyoming Care Management Entity High Fidelity Wraparound is a process that brings people together from different areas of a family's life to form a team. The team creates steps to help youth stay in their homes, schools and communities. Wyoming Care Management Entity High Fidelity Wraparound is guided by the following principles:

The Wraparound Fidelity Index, Short Form (WFI-EZ) assesses how well wraparound services align to the 10 core principles of the wraparound model defined by the National Wraparound Initiative. The WFI-EZ also explores youth and family service satisfaction and outcome success.

WFI- EZ results based on responses from caregivers and youth who have participated in Magellan of Wyoming's HFWA program demonstrate consistency in strengths for all roles with all elements either exceeding or meeting the National Means. These results indicate high rates of fidelity to the program and principles of High Fidelity Wraparound.

Total Fidelity Scores In Wyoming, the Caregiver total fidelity to the High Fidelity Wraparound model is 5.3% higher than the national comparison. The youth total fidelity score in Wyoming is 74.4% compared to the national mean of 69.3%. Total Fidelity WY compared to National Norms FY22


Wyoming has consistently yielded fidelity scores higher than the national mean for over 6 years.




Satisfaction

Caregiver

WFI-EZ results indicate Youth and families report higher rates of satisfaction with Wyoming Caregiver Management Entity High Fidelity Wraparound services in comparison to the national mean. Specifically, Caregiver and Youth scored similar satisfaction with progress made with the support of Wyoming Caregiver Management Entity High Fidelity Wraparound with 89% satisfaction for the caregiver and 90% reported by the youth.

Satisfaction Caregiver and Youth Compared to National Mean FY22




Outcomes

Youth and family engagement and participation in the Wyoming High Fidelity Wraparound Program indicates positive outcomes.

Families are more likely to see:

- Youth staying in their homes,
- Experience less emergency room visits,
- See a decrease in negative police contact
- Risk for school suspension or expulsion is lowered



- 10.5% (National Mean 21%) were placed for a period of time in an institution, such as detention, RTC, group home, or hospital;
- 9.5% (National Mean 13%) were reported to have visited an emergency room for a mental health problem;
- **15.8%** (National Mean 21%) were reported to have experienced a negative contact with police; and,
- 18.4% of youth (National Mean 24%) were reported to have experienced a suspension or expulsion from school.
