



## Annual Patient Access API Usage Metrics Report

In compliance with the CMS Interoperability and Prior Authorization final rule (CMS-0057-F)<sup>1</sup>, beginning in 2026, and annually thereafter, Magellan must report metrics in the form of aggregated, de-identified data on the number of patients who use the Patient Access API.
